LOS ANGELES HARBOR COLLEGE

Los Angeles Harbor College is located at the southern end of the City of Los Angeles in Wilmington. The past year's projects included the modernization of the Nursing, Theatre, Music and Fine Arts Buildings, the completion of the renovation of the Southwest Athletic Fields and start of the construction of the Facilities Maintenance Operations Building, the Northeast Academic Building and the Student Services Building. In addition, Harbor College has received a new 330-ton absorption chiller that was donated by the U.S. Department of Energy. This chiller, its companion cooling tower, and four micro-turbines donated by The Gas Company are an integral part of the College's new energy-efficient Central Plant design.
