Chapter, to Honor Larry H. Eisenberg at 2006 Annual Awards Banquet

*Eisenberg Currently Oversees the Los Angeles Community College District's \$2.2 Billion
Proposition A/ AA Bond Construction Program*

April 26, 2006 (LOS ANGELES) – The Southern California Chapter of the Construction Management Association of America will honor Larry H. Eisenberg, Executive Director of Facilities Planning and Development for the Los Angeles Community College District, at its 2006 annual awards banquet in Downtown Los Angeles on Thursday, April 27.

Eisenberg has more than 15 years experience in facilities planning management, and currently oversees the \$2.2 billion Proposition A /AA Bond construction program for the nine college Los Angeles Community College District. The Proposition A/ AA Bonds provide voter-approved funds for new construction and renovation projects at each of the nine Los Angeles Community Colleges. Eisenberg oversees all planning, facilities development, maintenance and real estate activities of the District. This includes oversight of the DMJM/JGM construction program management team, the nine College project management companies and all internal District facilities staff.

The banquet will be held at the Downtown Los Angeles Marriott, and will coincide with the Association's Vision 2006 conference. Geared toward construction managers, contractors, engineers, architects, and other construction professionals, the conference will explore trends and issues in the field of construction management. During the awards banquet, Eisenberg will present a multi-media overview of the Proposition A/AA program.

The Proposition A /AA Bond program is currently the largest public sector sustainable building program in the United States.
