**\$2.2 Billion L.A. Community College Construction Program to

The dinner and presentation begin at 6:30 p.m. at the Marriott Hotel in Downtown Los Angeles. This event is geared towards construction managers, contractors, engineers, architects, and others interested in upcoming opportunities for construction and professional services. Tickets are \$55 for CMAA members; \$85 for non-members. Guy Mehula, chief facilities executive for the Los Angeles Unified School District, will also present an update for its new schools construction program at the event.
