- The Downtown Dash “F” bus stops at Washington and Figueroa. Walk two blocks east along Washington to campus.

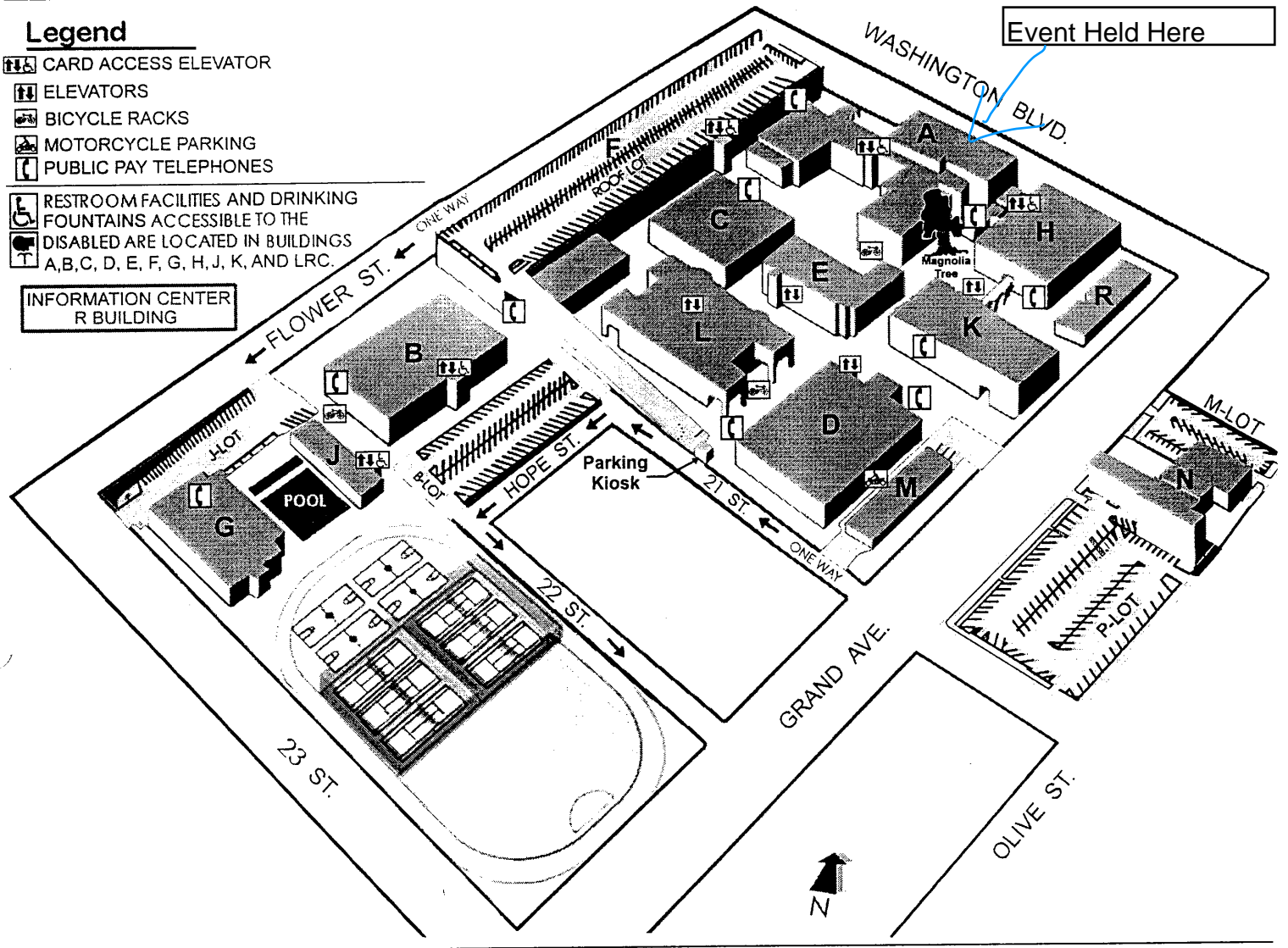
