G8 Physics & Earth Sciences Building

The 26,000 square-foot, two-story, G8 Physics and Earth Sciences building completes the 120,000 square-foot Science Career & Mathematics Complex (SCMC) at East Los Angeles College. This building is part of the new campus quad which includes the Campus Student Center Bookstore and the Ernest H. Moreno Language Arts and Humanities building. The building will be used by Anthropology, Astronomy, Geography, Geology, and Physics departments. This building will offer five classrooms and five laboratories.

Spacious in its design, this LEED Certified building provides clear circulation and generous interiors filled with natural lighting.

East Los Angeles College serves more than 35,000 students in the Los Angeles suburb of Monterey Park, and is the largest campus in the district. The college offers both academic transfer courses which prepare students for admission to four-year colleges and universities as well as occupational programs which prepare students for careers in two years or less.
