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24th Street Parking Structure

The new parking structure located on 24th Street between Grand Avenue and Hill Street offers 981 parking spaces. The ground floor offers 25 electric vehicle charging stations. Emergency phones have been installed on all levels structure and provide direct video and audio contact with the campus security. Also located in the parking structure is an emergency generator in case of power failure. The newly installed fire alarm system ties into the central monitoring system that gives direct access to campus security.

Located on the 6th floor/roof of the structure are 1,199 Photovoltaic (PV) panel arrays. There is also a solar meter located on the ground floor, which displays real-time PV energy production data.

LATTC offers as nearly as 90 different occupational programs, some of these programs can be completed within a year. It also offers courses that are required for transferring to a university to four-year College. Trade-Tech is the oldest of the nine public two-year colleges in the District.
