

Classroom Door Locks, Phase 1

District-wide - The Los Angeles Community College District set standards for door hardware and locking capabilities available for interior classroom doors.

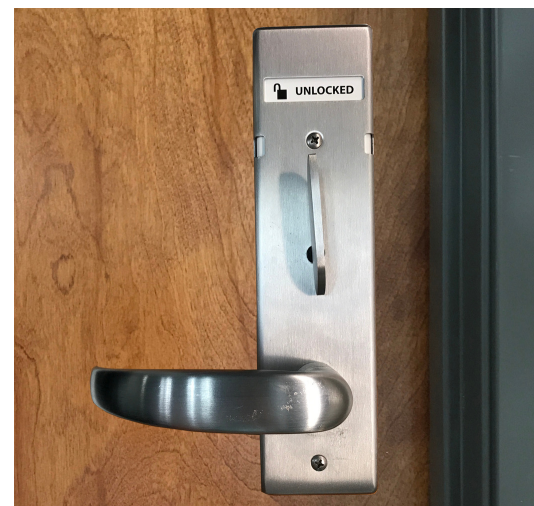
Over the Summer of 2018, field crews verified classroom doors at all Colleges, validating the type of door, existing locking hardware and level of effort required to bring the doors into compliance.

Installation will begin on all Colleges in February 2019 for Phase 1 doors.

Prior to commencing any work, the contractor will meet with each College to coordinate all field activities and provide an implementation schedule. Work will take place between 11:00pm and 7:00am to minimize disruption to classes.

In the second quarter of 2019, the project's Phase 2 will commence design on the remaining interior classroom doors and incorporation of card readers into the Physical Access Control System (PACS).
