S.A.I.L.S- Student Union

S.A.I.L.S. Student Union will be the newest addition to Los Angeles Harbor College. This 2-level, 59,000 square foot building will be the future home to the Culinary Arts program and will centralize all the student life programs offered by the college. Culinary Arts students will learn the latest cooking and baking techniques in state-of-the-art demonstration classroom labs designed with stadium-styled seating and Audio-Visual projection capabilities. Second-year students will learn from a living lab designed to create a full-scale cafeteria and fine dining restaurant, simulating a real-life dining setting.

The Student Union will also include Food Service, the Student Bookstore, Student Activities/ASO, the Business Office and offers a multi-purpose area for students to meet, socialize, and study.

This LEED Silver building features drought-tolerant landscaping, low-flow water fixtures and implements storm water infrastructure. The building includes a Sarnafil Energy Smart CRRC approved roof system with an SRI over 29.

Since 1949, Los Angeles Harbor College has grown from an enrollment of 400 students to a current enrollment of approximately 10,000 students. The college offers programs for students to choose from several occupational training programs in business and office administration, electronics technology, computer technology and nursing. Located in Wilmington, it is centrally located to serve residents from Wilmington, Carson, Harbor City, Lomita, Gardena, Palos Verdes, San Pedro and Torrance.
