# **Science Complex**

Centrally located on the Los Angeles Harbor College campus, the 74,000 square-foot, three-story Science Complex is home to the college's Biology, Chemistry, and Physics programs. With a combination of 24 classrooms and laboratories, and an outdoor solar lab the Science Complex is well equipped with state-of-the-art equipment to enhance the learning experience of all students in the Life and Physical Science Departments. Along with these departments the Science Complex also houses the Math Tutoring Center, STEM Office and student lounge, as well as four 120-seat auditoriums.

Equipped with a 1,200-panel photovoltaic system, natural ventilation, integrated energy recovery systems, and numerous other sustainability technologies, the Science Complex has also been awarded an LEED Rating of Platinum. Designed with sustainability in mind, the complex utilizes open corridors and exterior classrooms to reduce the energy loads while also providing a very inviting and spacious learning environment.

Los Angeles Harbor College is the only community college in the Los Angeles Community College District that serves the South Bay Region with a student population of over 8,800. With a focus on student-centered learning the college strives to empower the educational pathways of all students by offering courses for transfer or associate degrees, certificates, workplace development, and technical training. The College has numerous partnerships with local businesses and industries to enhance the learning experience for students.
