## **School of Science**

The new School of Science building will include a large lecture hall and nine laboratories specialized for different disciplines. The two-story, 26,790 square foot building will be a LEED Certified, steel framed structure that is designed to be in harmony with existing campus buildings. The building includes classrooms, laboratories, stockrooms, storage, a shared lecture hall, and administrative spaces for Life Sciences, Chemistry, Physics, and Earth Sciences faculty.

The building design includes two exterior staircases, and elevator and a roof-top observation deck for the Astronomy program.

The building will include energy efficient appliances and incorporates a storm water management system, drought tolerant landscape, daylight sensors for lighting, LED Light Fixtures, "cool" roofing system, and recycling stations.
