

Small Contractor Boot Camp!

The Los Angeles Community College District's (LACCD) Small Contractor Boot Camp is a foursession program explicitly designed for small contractors to improve their competitive bidding capacity. Through a comprehensive curriculum, small contractors will learn more about the prequalification process for the BuildLACCD Program's Pre-Qualified Service Provider (PQSP) bench, PQSP contracts for projects ranging from \$25K - \$5M, how to bid for contracts, and how to execute BuildLACCD construction projects successfully.

- Access to Capital
- Estimating & Scheduling
- Safety
- Sustainability
- Labor Compliance
- Project Labor Agreement (PLA)
- Local Worker Hire Program

The Board of Trustees established a 30% Local, Small, Emerging, and Disabled Veteran (LSEDV) participation goal for all BuildLACCD contracts.
