The new 118,000 square foot Academic and Cultural Center will provide Los Angeles Valley College with a state-of-the-art hub for media and performing arts facility, expanding opportunities for learning, creativity and community engagement.

The three-story facility will feature a variety of indoor and outdoor performing spaces, including a 430-seat Main Theatre, 221-seat Screening Theatre, and a 143-seat Horseshoe Theatre. These venues will support student productions, performances, and academic events.

Designed to mirror professional creative environments, the building will feature seven rehearsal and studio rooms, six audio/video labs and large lecture halls. Students will elevate their academic experience in the college radio station, smart classrooms, production/control rooms, and a Foley room. Supporting spaces, like the green rooms and scene shop for set building will provide students a full hands-on experience for careers in the performing arts.

The outdoor amphitheater will be surrounded by drought tolerant landscaping and meandering pathways to naturally link the facility to the campus academic core.

Founded in 1949, Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) is located in the heart of the San Fernando Valley and offers over 160 associate degrees and certificate programs. Known as an urban oasis, the campus has over 1,600 trees and holds the distinction of being the first community college in California to be recognized as a Tree Campus USA.
