The Marquee and Campus Fencing project will transform the public facing edges and elevate the College presence in the community. The project compliments the new Southeast Academic Hall and completes the vision for a signature entrance to the campus.

Replacement of the existing 74-foot-tall marquee includes upgrading the technology used for the double-side 1,296 square foot face to reduce light pollution and efficiently manage College information, special events and key announcements. Located on Figueroa Place at L Street, it will be lit by energy-efficient LED lighting and use smart lighting controls to adjust to ambient lighting. Other upgrades include a UPS to provide backup power, as needed, a new electrical panel and power supplies.

The new metal fence will replace existing and add new fencing, 11 pedestrian and 10 vehicle access gates around the entire perimeter of the 80-acre campus. Many of the gates will include the capability for remote and programmable access control to improve efficiency and safety.

In addition, the project will add an additional accessible parking stall and improve the existing path of travel from Parking Lot 6.
